Dennis showed up to our Toastmasters meeting, mid meeting, and assaulted another member, Jason Nellis, in front of our entire club. Dennis charged at Jason, knocking over tables and chairs, jumped towards and hit Jason in the head. Members of the club tried to break it up. Jason ran off and Dennis rode off on his motorcycle shortly after. Dennis returned several more times that evening, revving his motorcycle engine in the parking lot outside our meeting room for minutes at a time before leaving again. When the meeting was over he was back outside the exit revving his engine some more. The club felt terrorized, afraid to leave the building. Another member of the club, Tom Maroney, told me after the meeting he saw Dennis had pulled out a handgun and Tom saw that it was loaded. After we heard Dennis ride off, Tom followed me home in his car. When we both got to my house, I saw the power to the house was cut. The power had been switched off from the circuit breaker accessed through the entrance on the back side of the house. Tom helped me switch the power back on and check around the house and yard to make sure Dennis had left. When the house was cleared, Tom left. Within minutes of him leaving, Dennis returned to the house and began pounding on the front door screaming at me "Send your boyfriend out, I know he's in there." I call 911 immediately and call for police response. While I am on the phone with the operator, Dennis was revving his bike engine on the street outside my house. He left before the police showed up. He had sent both myself and Jason Nellis threatening texts that same evening and also informed Jason that he was watching the house from the bar across the street.

What Happened?

Dennis threatened to and followed through with his threat to poison my cat. I was away from the house when he texted me that my cat will be drinking anti-freeze. I immediately returned home and Dennis was still at my house. I called 911 and he rode off on his motorcycle. I checked the cats' feeding area and he had poured a small puddle of anitfreeze over the cat's food. I cleaned it up before the police arrived.

Dennis was still living with me at the time. We got into a terrible fight and this was the first time Dennis became violent with me. He took my unloaded rifle and was holding it like a baseball bat and told me he was going to smash my laptop. I tried to stop him and threw me on the bed and put all of his weight on me. When he got off me he stopped and reached into his vest where he keeps his gun. He said "I could end you right now if I wanted to." He left the house shortly after but before leaving went into the garden and ripped out my broccoli plants I was saving for seed. The next morning I went outside and saw my backyard patio furniture had been thrown all over the yard, my glass topped table smashed against the brick wall, and a nearly full gallon jug of antifreeze had been dumped all over the hood of my car.

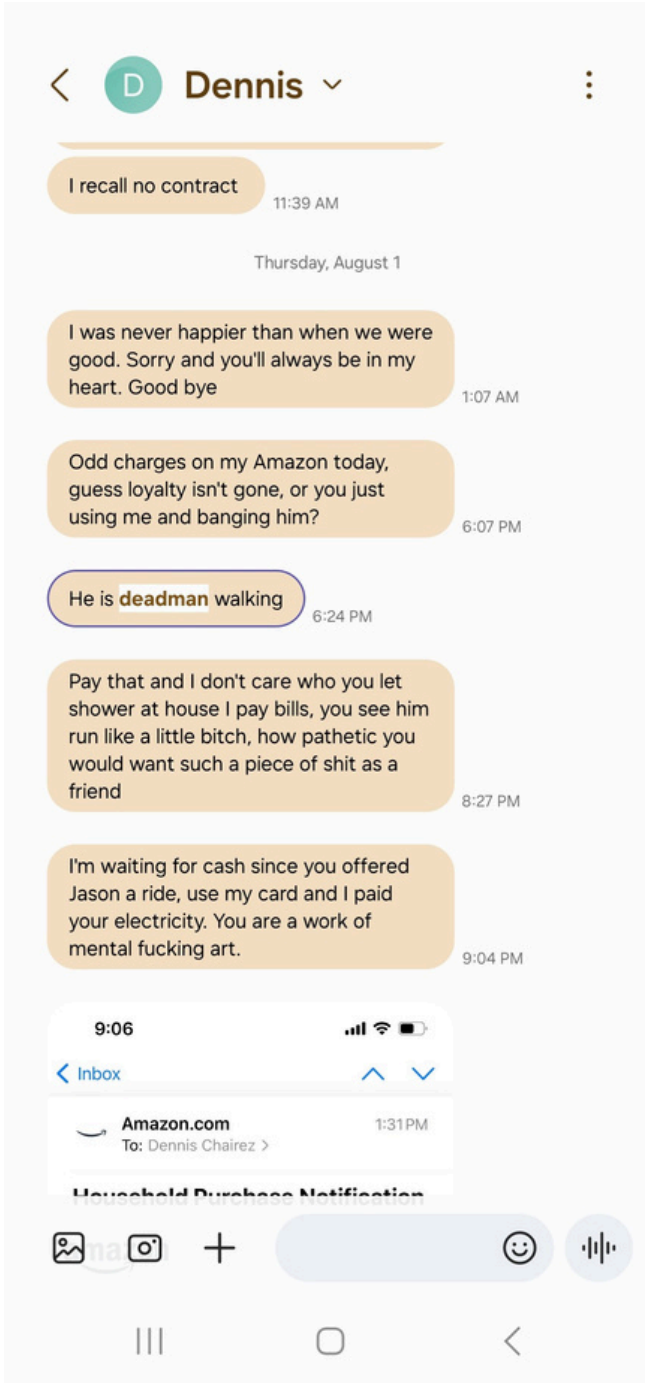

I am reaching out to relay a situation that may warrant the attention of WHQ. This regards I'll Drink To That - Club 3254.

A synopsis:

There is a couple in the club that currently has a fractured marital relationship. One week ago during a Thursday evening club meeting, the husband arrived and immediately attacked another male member in the club. Fellow members were able to break up the altercation and convince the husband to leave, without police intervention.

At the end of the meeting the club determined that they no longer want the husband to be a member of the club. The wife sent a text message to the husband relaying the club's decision. The husband has since responded saying that he plans to see everyone at the club meeting this evening.

To my knowledge, there are no club meeting minutes of this member being voted in. Nor did they take meeting minutes after voting him out.

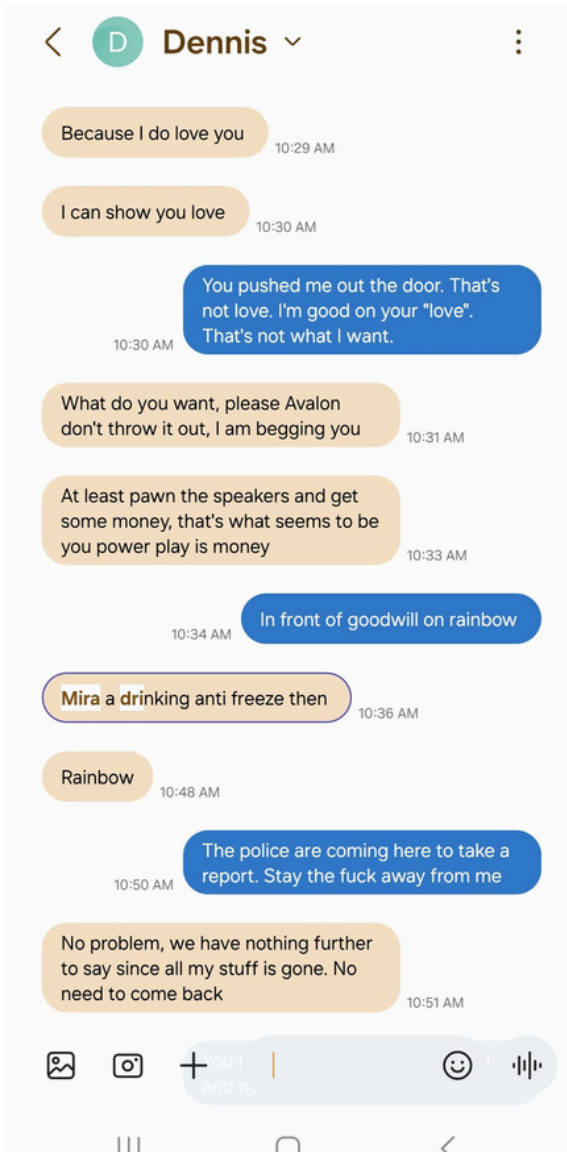
Club members are attempting to work with bar/restaurant management to have the husband barred from the premises. There is security footage of the incident. There is a concern that this situation could leave a negative impression of Toastmasters, and impact other clubs that meet at this same location. There is also concern that the husband may try to join other clubs in the Toastmasters/District 115 system.

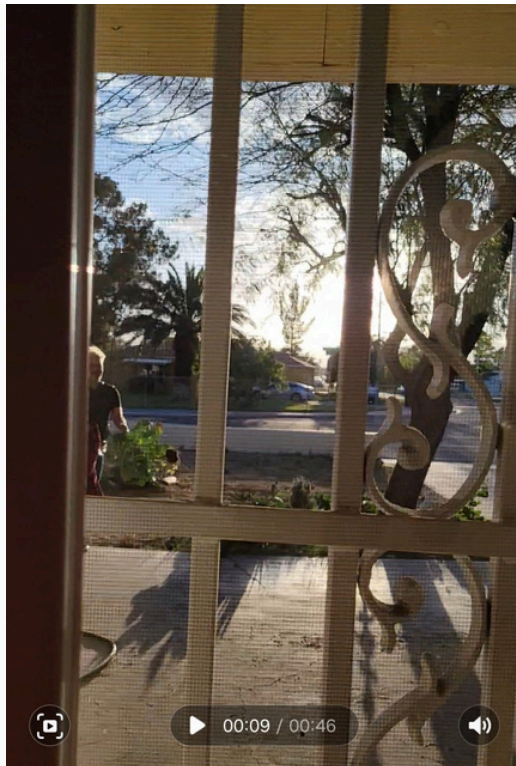

whom you are related by blood or marriage, a person with whom you have had or are having a dating relationship or a person with whom you have a child in common, and if I had a face-to-face encounter with the person suspected of committing the battery that was of sufficient duration to determine whether probable cause existed while responding to the initial incident or call for service, I am required, unless mitigating circumstances exist, to arrest the person suspected of committing the battery.

If I have probable cause to believe that a battery has been committed against you, your minor child or the minor child of the person believed to have committed the battery in the last seven days by your spouse, any other person to whom you are related by blood or marriage, a person with whom you have had or are having a dating relationship or a person with whom you have a child in common, and if I did not have a face-to-face encounter with the person suspected of committing the battery that was of sufficient duration to determine whether probable cause existed while responding to the initial incident or call for service, I am required, unless mitigating circumstances exist, to arrest the person suspected of committing the battery.

If I am unable to arrest the person suspected of committing the battery, you have the right to request that the prosecutor file a criminal complaint against the person. I can provide you with information on this procedure. If convicted, the person who committed the battery may be placed on probation, ordered to see a counselor, put in jail or fined.

It is a federal crime to possess a firearm while subject to a qualifying protection order or after conviction of a qualifying misdemeanor crime of domestic violence.
